Sudbury Youth Football and Cheer is a 501c3 non-profit which is proud to provide an annual scholarship to a deserving graduating Lincoln- Sudbury Regional High School Senior who has participated in the SYFC Football and Cheer program.

Eligibility

To be eligible to receive the scholarship, an applicant must meet all the following requirements:

- A current high school senior graduating in the school year in which the award is offered.
- A current or past participant in the Sudbury Youth Football and Cheer program, with 3 or more seasons as a player on an SYFC roster or as a demonstrator in our cheer program.
- Proof of acceptance to an institution of higher education (accredited 2-year, 4-year college, or trade school) or acceptance into one of the four branches of the U.S. military or US Coast Guard.
- Completion of the application below, including provision of requested transcripts.

Personal Statement

Submit a personal statement of 300 to 500 words (typewritten pages) as described and include the following:

1. Reason(s) you selected the college, trade school, or branch of military to which you have been admitted.
2. Reason(s) you feel that you should receive the scholarship
3. Benefits you've received from your experience with Football or Cheerleading
4. Contributions to the community you feel you can make while in post-secondary education



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2020 Application Checklist

- All applications must be postmarked by April 14th, 2020.
- Copy of Your most recent school transcript.
- Completed personal statement.
- Signed statement of support for your application from a schoolteacher or administrator, coach, or member your community
- Proof of acceptance to an institute of higher education or the military
- The completed application.
